



Coalition to Salute America's Heroes Summary Financial Statement for 2010

The Coalition to Salute America's Heroes (CSAH) continued to focus its activities in 2010 on helping severely wounded veterans who had served our country in Iraq and Afghanistan. As of year's end, the Coalition had provided financial aid and program services to over 19,900 wounded veterans since its inception in 2004. This assistance was provided through a range of activities including the Coalition's Holiday Gift Check program (Easter, Thanksgiving, and Christmas) and our Emergency Financial Aid Program for wounded veterans, many of whom are identified by our Field Representatives during their visits with veterans at VA and Department of Defense hospitals. The Coalition also provides assistance through its Road to Recovery Conferences for wounded veterans and their families and its veteran-staffed "work at home" Partner Appreciation Program. In addition, the Coalition undertakes extensive public awareness activities to inform the public about the needs of our wounded veterans and to encourage individual citizens to contact their elected representatives and seek better care from our government for those who have given so much for us.
